



## Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

### *Serving those who have served*

**The SSVF program provides intensive case management to help participants increase their ability to sustain permanent housing and reach their greatest potential.**

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) is a program to assist very low-income veteran families. Case managers will work with veteran families to identify and access VA benefits and other public benefits.

#### **Participant Requirements:**

- A **veteran** who is a single person, the head of a household or the spouse of the head of household who was discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.
- Homeless or at risk of homelessness looking to maintain permanent housing
- Income is less than 50% of Area Median Income (AMI)
- Capable of sustaining permanent housing after short term, intensive case management and/or financial assistance
